
Project Highlights

Two semi-integrated spaces for MIC's Global Services and Atlantic Aviation airport services business lines; Dynamic space and branding that expresses its clear mission; Culture change from offices and cubicles to benching with additional collaboration spaces; Flexible training space and central break room

Macquarie Infrastructure Corporation (MIC), an owner, operator, and investor in infrastructure businesses, looked to relocate two of its business lines: Atlantic Aviation, a national airport services business, and MIC Global Services, a support and logistics group for the entire portfolio. Through visioning sessions and staff surveys, MIC and the design team established daylight, dynamic branding, and space efficiency as key design and planning drivers.



The design team planned the floor so Atlantic Aviation is centralized in one corner while MIC Global Services filled the remaining work space. Both companies have their own reception with features similar in design but distinct branding and colors. Previously assigned either private offices or cubicles, a culture shift occurred with the new space as most employees now sit in benching workstations with shared, adjacent collaborative spaces. Vibrant graphics in the shared spaces add to the fun environment with words that reinforce their culture. The central break room and flexible training space allow for various types of larger gatherings.
